

Elmwood Park Public Library Wireless Internet Use Policy

Elmwood Park Public Library provides wireless Internet access (Wi-Fi) at no cost to patrons with Wi-Fi enabled devices. The wireless network is open and unsecured.

Policy

- The wireless network is not meant as a replacement for the wired network and is not intended to be a patron's primary Internet connection.
- Wi-Fi at Elmwood Park Public Library is firewalled and filtered.
- Library staff will not provide technical assistance for wireless networking.
- Users may not extend or modify the network in any way. Any unauthorized access points will be removed or disabled.
- Unauthorized access to other (library or patron) computers is prohibited. Such attempts may result in the suspension of all access.
- Elmwood Park Public Library reserves the right to limit the bandwidth of the wireless network in order to ensure overall network reliability.
- Restricting or monitoring the access of minors on the Library's wireless network is the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian.

Liability

The transmission of personal, financial or legal data across the library's wireless network is done at the patron's own risk.

Library staff are not expected to provide technical assistance with wireless access and will not under any circumstances make changes to the configuration of a privately owned wireless device.

Elmwood Park Public Library's Wi-Fi network is provided "as-is". Compatibility and availability are not guaranteed. Environmental factors such as radio interference and traffic as well as location within the library and obstructions between the wireless device and access point may all affect access.

Policy Review and Revision

Elmwood Park Public Library Board of Trustees will review this document at least biennially.
